



4 Steps to apply for MDA Talent Assistance (Training) Grants through Six Degrees

Applicants should first have the following 4 soft documents ready beforehand to upload to their online grants application:

1. Photocopy of NRIC (front and back) in a single file
2. Copy of resume
3. Programme description and / or marketing material
4. Short write up of expected outcomes of training and relevance to career

Step 1:

Applicants to do a simple sign up with Six Degrees for a free basic account via: www.sixdegrees.asia

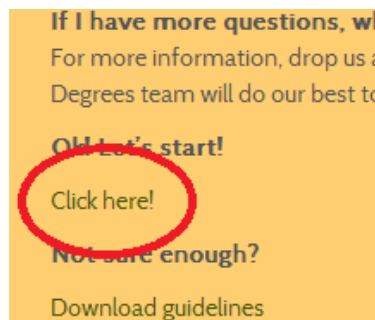
Step 2:

Once account has been activated and logged in, proceed to the Six Degrees home page and click on 'MDA Talent Assistance (Training)' link, as shown below.



Step 3:

Applicants are encouraged to read through the MDA Talent Assistance (Training) FAQs before clicking on the link to the online application form found near the bottom of the screen, as shown below.



Step 4:

Applicants are to fill up all the compulsory details and upload all the required documents. Upon applying successfully, Six Degrees will then conduct an assessment on the applicant's eligibility and follow up with the applicant within 7 working days via email.
